DOOR ENTRY CARDS ARE BACK

At the general Lodge membership meeting held in January, there was a vote in favor of installing a door entry card system. The new system will use proximity cards and will be activated for the 2 main entrance ways, from the parking area and from Main Street. Each member will receive 1 new card, free of charge. Replacement cards will cost members \$10.00 each. The reasons for returning to the entry card system included: Better tracking of members with expired dues; Stopping non-members from entering unnoticed; Increased safety for our members and for Lodge property. Moose International announces new membership campaign

Beginning March 1, 2010 and running through May 31, 2010, any Lodge or Chapter member who sponsors 2 new or former members will be entered into a drawing for one of three cruises aboard the Carnival Splendor, which sails to the Mexican Riviera from October 10—17, 2010. For each additional application reported during the campaign period, the sponsor will receive another entry in the drawing. Cruises will be awarded on April 1, May 1 and June 1, 2010. Sponsors are eligible to receive only one of the three cruises-for-two packages. This award is for the cruise only; it does not include air transportation to Los Angeles. Cruise tickets are transferable, but they must be used for the October 10 departure.

Now is the time to apply for the Moose International R. Robert Dale Scholarship. The following requirements must be met in order to be eligible. The applicant must:

Be a student in the high school graduating Class of 2011

Have a father, mother, step-parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is a paid up member of the Moose (applicant is not required to reside in the same household)

Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 (C+) or higher on a 4.0 scale

Send the completed application by deadline (**application must be completed in it's entirety to be valid**)

Faxed applications must be received by June 30, 2010. Mailed applications must be postmarked on or before June 30, 2010. Winners are randomly drawn and will be notified by November 15, 2010. Each \$1,000.00 check will be mailed directly to the college of their choice.

Golf Outings—we are looking for members interested in organizing a golf outing or two this summer.

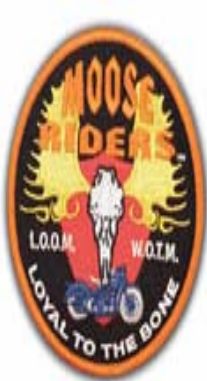
General help with cleaning and making needed repairs around the Lodge.

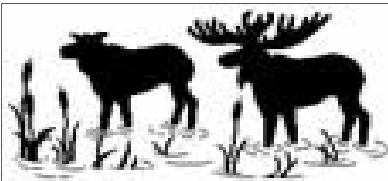
